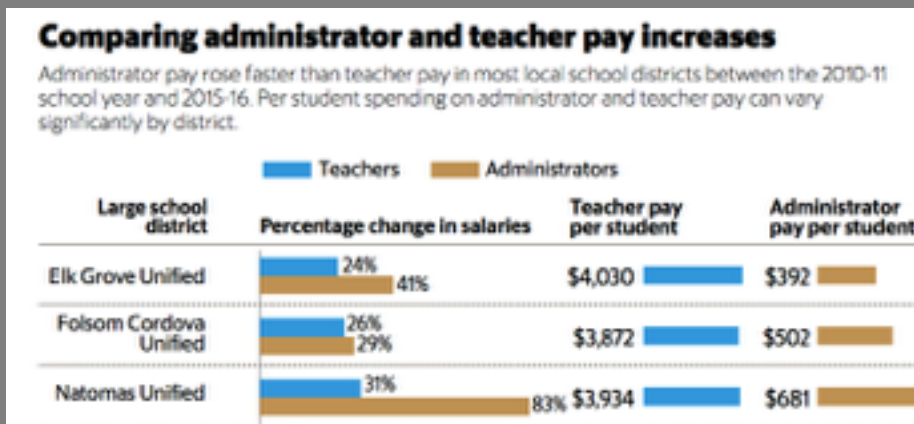
We continue to fight for a fair settlement on behalf of all students and teachers in Natomas.

Did you know... According to the Sacramento Bee on Our Superintendent Chris Evans:

“Evans, who runs the smallest of the six districts, with 14,895 students, also earned a 6 percent bonus, or \$17,580, in 2017, bringing his pay this school year to \$311,184. He also is eligible for extra pay if he works more than his contracted 220 days. His perks include \$12,000 a year toward an annuity, a \$500-a-month car allowance and a \$1,500 yearly technology stipend, along with the usual health benefits. Board President Scott Dosick defended the superintendent’s salary package. “It is a very competitive marketplace for good superintendents, and Chris has done a fantastic job for our district,” he said.
